

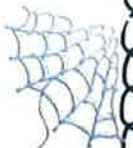

FALL BASKETS

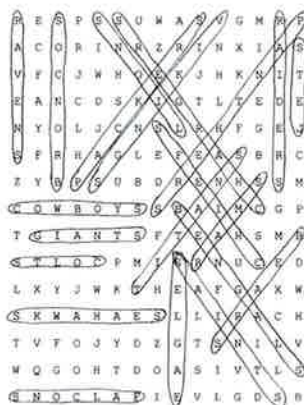

BED BUG INSPECTIONS

All Horizon Homes units will be inspected on Monday, November 7th and Tuesday, November 8th. The inspections will begin around 9:00 am. We are not certain as to which day or time the inspector will arrive at your unit. Please remember it is not necessary for you to be home during this inspection. Maintenance will be accompanying the inspector to each unit.

UNIT INSPECTIONS

Unit inspections will take place on Wednesday November 9th through Friday, November 11th. Everyone on the property should have received a letter in their mailbox as to what day they will be at your unit. During this inspection, the staff will be checking smoke detectors, emergency pull cords, changing furnace filters, and turning off outside waters. Housekeeping will be inspected at this time as well. Please remember it is not necessary for you to be home during this inspection.

OFFICE CLOSED

The office will be closing at noon on Tuesday, November 8th and will not re-open until Friday, November 11th at 9 am, due to continuing education training. As usual, if you have an emergency or a work order to report and it is during regular business hours, please call 812-479-0456. However, if you have an after-hours emergency that cannot wait until the next business day, please call 812-471-7402.

DROP BOX

Remember that you still live in an apartment community for 55 and older and we must respect our neighbor's privacy, as well. REFLECTIONS OF U.S.:

NUTS AND CRANBERRIES! : F.D.R.'S THANKSGIVING FIASCO

“Nuts and Cranberries!” This was the response of the town of McGregor, Texas when our nation’s 32nd President, Franklin Delano Roosevelt (1882-1945; President, 1933-1945) moved Thanksgiving up to the third Thursday in November. What was the reason? According to an article in an August 1939 issue of Newsweek, moving the holiday up earlier would help Christmas shopping efforts. A store in Kokomo, Indiana had a sign on its window that said:

“Do your shopping now - - -

Who knows?

Tomorrow may be Christmas.”



This was done at the request of a group of business owners, known as the National Retail Dry Goods Association, and in 1939 and 1940, Thanksgiving was celebrated one week earlier. While twenty-three states rallied with Roosevelt for the third Thursday, another twenty-three refused and celebrated on the traditional fourth Thursday. Maine, Colorado, and Texas went one step further and celebrated Thanksgiving - - - believe it or not - - - on both Thursdays. Most folks called it “Franksgiving” scornfully by most. Roosevelt’s third Thursday experiment was a total failure, and in the spring of 1941, by a joint resolution of Congress, Thanksgiving was restored and put back on the fourth Thursday in November, once and for all, the way Abraham Lincoln intended in 1863. Roosevelt signed the bill into law and Thanksgiving was safe. One humorous note..... Roosevelt notified the birthplace of Thanksgiving, Plymouth, Massachusetts, because of a previous engagement, he could not attend the holiday ceremonies on the 30th of November.
